Coaches Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

Coaches are responsible for developing players in a safe, respectful, and structured environment.

This Code ensures all coaching activities align with the club's values and Football Victoria (FV) standards.

2. Responsibilities

Coaches must:

- Act as positive role models both on and off the field
- Promote enjoyment, skill development, and participation
- Prioritize player welfare over winning

3. Behaviour Standards

Coaches will:

- Treat all players equally regardless of ability, gender, or background
- Show respect to referees, officials, opponents, and spectators
- Avoid aggressive, abusive, or inappropriate language
- Never engage in discrimination, harassment, or bullying

4. Safety & Welfare

Coaches must:

- Provide a safe training and match environment
- Ensure activities are age-appropriate
- Follow safeguarding and child protection policies
- Report any incidents or concerns immediately

5. Compliance

Coaches must:

- Follow all Football Victoria (FV) and Football Australia (FA) rules and club policies
- Cooperate with club management and officials
- Maintain professionalism at all times

6. Breaches

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings
- Suspension from coaching duties
- Removal from coaching position
