Photography & Media Consent Policy

1. Purpose

Tarneit North Football Club recognises the importance of protecting the privacy, safety, and wellbeing of all members, particularly children and young people.

This policy outlines how photographs, videos, and media content may be collected, used, stored, and shared by the club.

2. Scope

This policy applies to:

- Players
- Parents and guardians
- Coaches
- Volunteers
- Officials
- Committee members
- Spectators and supporters
- Any individual involved in club activities

3. Photography and Media Collection

The club may capture photographs and videos during:

- Matches
- Training sessions
- Presentations and events
- Community activities
- Club programs and promotions

4. Purpose of Media Use

Images and media may be used for:

- Club promotion
- Social media content
- Club website updates
- Newsletters and publications
- Community engagement
- Recognition of achievements and participation

5. Respectful and Appropriate Use

All photography and media must:

- Respect the dignity and privacy of individuals
- Represent the club positively
- Avoid inappropriate, offensive, or unsafe content
- Be suitable for a family-friendly sporting environment

6. Child Safety Considerations

Extra care must be taken when photographing or filming children and young people.

Images should:

- Be appropriate and respectful
- Avoid personal or identifying information where possible
- Not place children at risk
- Comply with child safeguarding expectations

7. Consent and Requests

Parents, guardians, or individuals may request limitations on the use of specific images or media involving themselves or their children.

The club will consider reasonable requests regarding privacy and media usage.

8. Social Media and Public Sharing

Members sharing club-related content online are expected to:

- Use respectful and appropriate content
- Avoid harmful or offensive posts
- Respect privacy and consent expectations
- Follow the club's Social Media Policy

9. Storage and Access

Media files may be stored electronically by authorised club representatives for legitimate club purposes.

Reasonable steps will be taken to protect stored media content.

10. Breaches of Policy

Inappropriate use of photography or media may result in disciplinary action, including:

- Removal of content
- Warnings
- Suspension from club activities
- Further action where necessary

11. Policy Review

This policy may be reviewed and updated periodically to reflect changes in club operations, safeguarding expectations, or legal requirements.
