Supporters Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct outlines the expected behaviour of all supporters at Tarneit North Football Club. Supporters play a vital role in creating a positive, respectful, and enjoyable environment for players, officials, and the wider community.

2. General Expectations

All supporters must:

- Encourage players in a positive and respectful manner
- Support fair play and good sportsmanship at all times
- Respect all players, coaches, referees, and officials
- Represent the club in a positive and responsible way

3. Behaviour Standards

Supporters will:

- Avoid the use of abusive, offensive, or inappropriate language
- Not engage in harassment, discrimination, or bullying
- Respect referee decisions and not challenge or undermine officials
- Refrain from aggressive or disruptive behaviour during matches or training

4. Match Day Conduct

Supporters are expected to:

- Follow all venue and club rules and guidelines
- Remain in designated spectator areas where applicable
- Allow players, coaches, and officials to perform their roles without interference
- Promote a safe and welcoming environment for all participants

5. Respect & Inclusion

Supporters must:

- Respect diversity and inclusion within the club
- Treat all individuals equally regardless of background, ability, or identity
- Contribute to a supportive and inclusive club culture

6. Compliance

All supporters must comply with:

- Tarneit North Football Club policies and rules
- Football Victoria (FV) and Football Australia (FA) regulations
- Any venue or competition requirements

7. Disciplinary Action

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings
- Removal from matches or club events

- Further action as determined by the club
