Players Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for all players representing Tarneit North Football Club. It ensures that all participants contribute to a safe, respectful, and positive football environment.

2. General Expectations

All players must:

- Play fairly and follow the Laws of the Game

3. Behaviour Standards

Players will:

- Avoid the use of abusive, offensive, or inappropriate language
- Not engage in bullying, harassment, or discrimination
- Respect referee decisions without argument or dissent
- Support teammates and encourage a positive team environment

4. Commitment & Responsibility

Players are expected to:

- Attend training sessions and matches regularly and on time
- Inform coaches or team managers of any absence in advance
- Follow instructions given by coaches and club officials
- Take responsibility for their actions on and off the field

5. Safety & Welfare

Players must:

- Prioritize their own safety and the safety of others
- Use equipment responsibly and as instructed
- Report any injuries, concerns, or unsafe behaviour immediately
- Follow all club safeguarding and welfare policies

6. Compliance

All players must comply with:

- Tarneit North Football Club rules and policies
- Football Victoria (FV) and Football Australia (FA) regulations
- Any additional team or competition guidelines

7. Disciplinary Action

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings

- Suspension from training or matches
- Removal from team or club activities
